

Upskilling Scotland Scholarship - Application Terms and Conditions

1. All information detailing how to apply for the scholarship forms part of these terms and conditions. Submission of an application will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
2. To be eligible to apply to the scholarship scheme, applicants should reside in Scotland or work in Scotland. Fully complete the scholarship application form and submit it with a copy of a Council Tax Bill, driver's license, or Utility bill.
3. The scholarship fully funds one course worth £1,200 - £1,440.
4. The application deadline for all EBS Upskilling Scotland courses ends on 31st July 2024.
5. Students are expected to sit an exam at the end of the course, the assessment fee is covered by the scholarship. The student will be registered for the first available assessment date at least 3 months from their course start date. This assessment can be deferred but the student has up to six assessment sittings (approx. two years) to sit an assessment from date of enrolment.
6. Access to the course materials will be withdrawn once the student has completed the assessment or six assessment diets have expired (approx. two years).
7. Successful applicants agree to be named, photographed, interviewed, and quoted and their verbal and or written testimonials used in publicity for Heriot-Watt University or Edinburgh Business School.
 - 18+ years of age.
 - Reside or have the legal right to work in Scotland
8. All candidates for the Upskilling Scotland funding must meet the eligibility criteria above.

Please note that Heriot-Watt University students who are already enrolled for a qualification are not eligible for Upskilling Scotland funding.

VISA Holders: The Upskilling Scotland Scholarship is a publicly funded initiative. Prior to submitting your application, kindly review the terms and conditions associated with your visa.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – PLEASE READ

If you are taking an EBS course, then upon commencement you will have been automatically registered to sit the assessment for your chosen course and details can be found in the 'studies/assessment registration' section of your Student Portal. If you are unable to sit your assessment, as scheduled, **you can make changes to the registered assessment entry within your portal up until the relevant reschedule deadline.** Please refer to the 'studies/assessment deadline' section within your Student Portal for more details. We have assessment sessions in April, August, and December of each year.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ABSENCE FROM A SCHEDULED ASSESSMENT WILL REQUIRE PAYMENT OF THE ASSESSMENT FEE WHEN SCHEDULING A NEW ASSESSMENT DATE.
