

ELECTIONS TO THE SENATE May/June 2016

COUNTING OF BALLOTS

School of Engineering and Physical Sciences

At the close of voting on 30 May 2016, the following candidates have been elected to serve for a threeyear term as Senators drawn from EPS:

Professor Vicki Stone Dr Gillian Thomson Dr Peter Kew Professor Stuart Macgregor Dr Mutasim Nour

A total of 74 valid ballot papers were returned.

Under the STV voting system, since there were 5 places available, the 'quota' was set at 13.33 votes (i.e. candidates needed to receive 13.33 or more votes to be elected).

The counting ran to six rounds,	which are summarised below:
