

Facility & Location	Description		
365 Room (2nd Floor, West Wing)	The 365 Room is located outside the library. The 365 Room is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year, and has 118 study spaces, including a silent PC room with 12 PCs (high-performance computers) and 5 individual carrels.		
Wheesht Room (2nd Floor, West Wing)	Next to the 365 Room is Wheesht, the 365 Silent Room. Wheesht has 76 individual study carrels and is open 24/7.		
Library (2nd Floor, West Wing)	The library provides 215 study spaces, which include: • 47 individual carrels in an open area • 18 individual carrels in the silent study room • 2 x 4 persons discussion rooms • 1 x 8 persons discussion room • 1 x 10 persons meeting room		
IT and Group Study Areas (2nd Floor, West Wing)	The IT & Group Study Area is designated for collaborative learning with group study and discussion areas. This room has 80 study spaces and includes 3×8 persons discussion tables.		
Student Common & Recreation Room (1st Floor, West Wing)	Now and then students need a break from studying. Our student common room serves this purpose, with plenty of activities for those who need to relax and socialise in between studying. The common room has board games. A pantry with facilities to make drinks and warm food is also available.		
Ping Pong/Dance Studio/Recreation Room (1st Floor, West Wing)	For those who unwind through dance or if you simply want to bat a ping-pong ball around with some friends, this is the place to be.		
Counselling and Disability Discussion Room (Ground Floor, East Wing)	As a University that always places a student's wellbeing first, we have a full-time counsellor with a dedicated room that any student can drop in at any time for a consultation.		
First Aid Room (Ground Floor, East Wing)	The health and safety of our students are always paramount. Our full-time Health and Safety team can always be found at their office located at the First Aid room. The room is equipped to handle first aid intervention until the arrival of medical personnel. The room is equipped with: • Adjustable beds • Examination table • Automated External Defibrillator • Full supplies of First Aid equipment and medication • Crutches • Wheelchairs • Automatic blood pressure gauge		
Postgraduate Common Room (3rd Floor, West Wing)	A room specially designated for our postgraduate students, which has comfortable sofas and seating areas for discussions or study.		

SafeZone Heriot-Watt University Malaysia is the first university in Asia to use SafeZone and provides all Heriot-Watt staff and students with the same level of support regardless of which campus they are working on.

SafeZone is an essential component of Heriot-Watt's new security service and is being fully integrated across all campuses with all security officers using SafeZone's OmniGuard app on their smartphones. Any requests for assistance are handled by competent first aiders who, as first responders, will have a display of the SafeZone Omniguard app to monitor activations on and off campus.

The primary role of SafeZone is to support staff and students while they are on campus or travelling, or during fieldwork but it also gives Heriot-Watt the flexibility to geofence additional areas as required.

The University's intention is to make the use of SafeZone best practice for any students or staff travelling on university business.
